- **The minimum requirement for admission to CDI College is a high school diploma, unless otherwise specified in the program outline.**
- **Where applicable, applicants must provide proof of graduation prior to enrolling or at the time of enrolment.**
- **Applicants who have not achieved a high school diploma can apply as a mature student.**
- **All applicants must provide proof of age and pass an entrance exam.**

Each CDI College program has its own admission requirements, such as minimum grade point average (GPA) and prerequisite courses. You can learn about the admission requirements of the program that interests you from your Admissions Representative, who will inform you of upcoming free information sessions in your area.

## Tuition & Financing

Your education is an investment in your future.

At CDI College, we know how imperative it is to select the right financing plan, which is why we are proud to offer you support from a Student Financial Planner. The Student Financial Planner will partner with you during the financing process to work out a payment plan by providing you information on a variety of affordable financing options to meet your educational needs.

We understand that every student comes from a unique financial background. That's why we offer a full range of financial solutions that will ensure you have the means to finance your education. Options available to you include:

### Government Assistance (Loans and Grants):

Government Financial Assistance is designed to help students pay for school. There are different types of financial assistance programs available, based on student eligibility and need. Students who require financial assistance may apply for student loans or grants through their respective provincial governments. The provincial and federal governments attempt to ensure all Canadians have the opportunity to attend post-secondary school and obtain the skills and knowledge they need to participate in the workforce.

Our Student Financial Planners are available to guide students who would like to explore this option and submit an application.

### Bank Line of Credits:

CDI College has partnered with major financial institutions to provide preferred lending arrangements for our students that are flexible, affordable and easy to obtain:

- Available to Canadian citizens & permanent residents enrolled in full-time or part-time post secondary studies
- Interest rate is variable and the loan amount is based on individual credit assessment
- Students pay monthly, interest-only payments on the funds they use, not on the total line of credit
- Upon graduation, students are entitled to a six-month period of interest-only payments

### Registered Retirement Savings Plan (RRSP):

Taxpaying students are able to withdraw money from their RRSPs for full time education and training for either themselves or their spouse/common-law partner on a tax free basis.

### Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP):

RESPs are registered education savings plans that permit savings to grow tax-free until the student beneficiary is ready to enroll full-time into a qualified post secondary institution. An RESP also allows the student to apply for the Canadian Education Savings Grant.

### Sponsored Students:

- **HRSDC & WCB Funding**

Eligible students can be sponsored by government agencies such as Workers' Compensation Board, and Human Resources and Skills Development Canada (HRSDC).

### Other Sources:

- **Corporate Reimbursement Programs**

Students who are employed may be eligible for tuition reimbursement through their employer's benefits program.

- **Veterans Affairs Act (Veterans Affairs Canada—VAC)**

Students who have served in the Canadian Forces (the navy, army, air force, or merchant navies) of Her Majesty, may be eligible for benefits under the various VAC programs. Eligibility criteria are different for each military educational assistance program and benefits vary.

- **Canada Pension Plan**

If you are a full-time student between the ages of 18 and 25 and your parent or guardian is receiving a Canada Pension Plan (CPP) disability benefit or has passed away, you may be eligible for a monthly payment from the CPP.

- **MADD Canada Bursary Fund**

The MADD Canada Bursary Fund is for Canadian students who have had a parent or guardian deceased as a result of an impaired-driving-related accident and is pursuing any full-time educational program that is approved by a provincial Ministry of Education. Bursaries of up to \$2000 can be awarded to qualifying students across Canada.

### Scholarships

From time to time, CDI College offers scholarships for specific programs to eligible students. Your Student Financial Planner will be able to tell you if you qualify for one or more of these programs. Your Student Financial Planner or Admissions Representative may also be able to provide information on other scholarships in your area.

It's important to note that there may be additional sources of third-party funding available to you. Many private businesses and community groups offer grants and scholarships to eligible students. Inquire with organizations in your area for more information.

### Tuition

You'll be informed of all fees related to your program of study during the admission process. Program costs may include fees for tuition, registration, learning guides, kits and course materials. Tuition may be paid through student loan disbursements or by cash, cheque, VISA, MasterCard or Interac.

The smaller class sizes are important because they allow you to have a closer relationship with your instructor, so you're not afraid to ask any questions. I loved going to school.

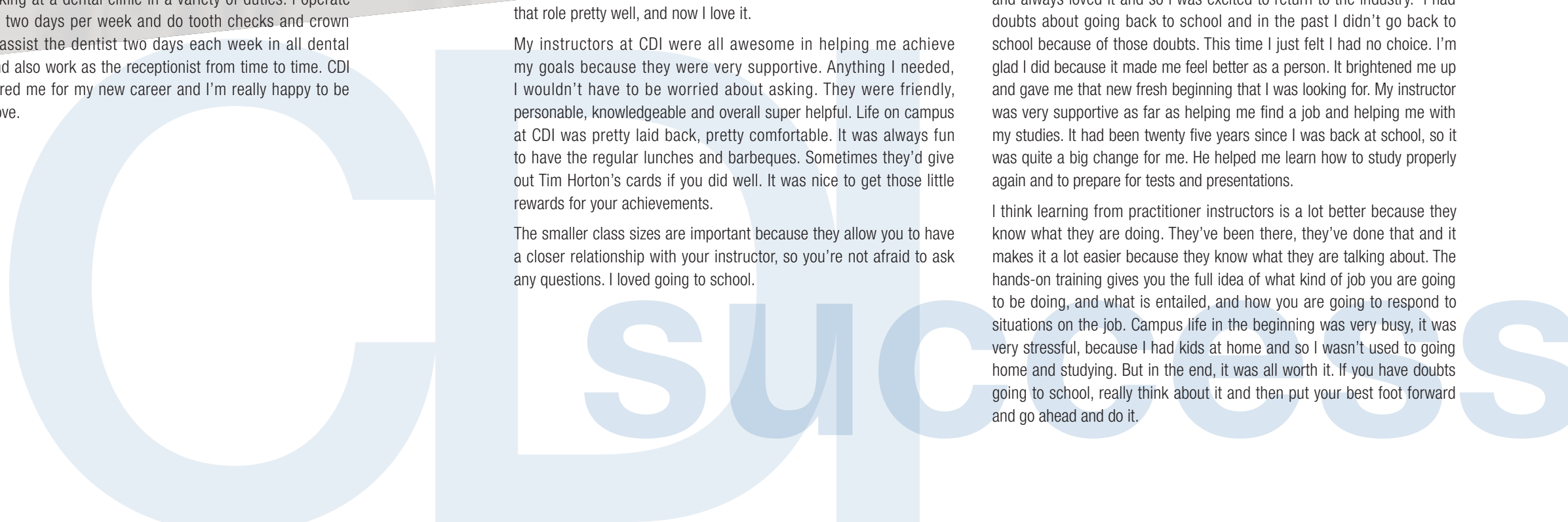
## Clemence A.
